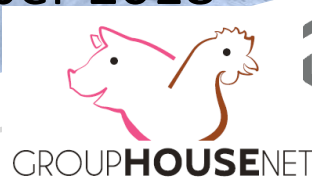


Genetics, Epigenetics and Neurobiology of Damaging Behaviour
